***Basic Flash Animation Class*** with Mr. Norwalt- Rm. 21

Class will focus on basics of web animation using Macromedia Flash. Students will integrate these animations into web pages.

Classes will be on Fridays, beginning January 13th. Fee- \$40.00.

***Fantasy Baseball*** with Mr. Johnson- Rm. 7

This program uses baseball as a context for mathematical concepts. In this 6-8 week unit, students become managers of their own Major League baseball team. They learn to analyze players' statistical data, make trades, arrange line-ups, and play simulated baseball games.

***Lego Robotics*** with Mr. Matras- Rm.33 is a fun, hands-on activity class.

Students build their own robotic creation using Legos. Then they learn how to use programming skills on the computer to program their Lego Robotic creation to perform different tasks. Every week students compete in a different Robotic Challenge.

This class must have 8-10 students for the class to make.

***Student Congress*** with Mrs. Burke- Rm. 36, will be offered at

8:15 AM on Thursday mornings, or for those who have an A-period class, it will be offered during lunch on Tuesdays. In this class, students will learn basic skills of debate and persuasion. Students develop speeches addressing the four current topics being debated in the Student Congress at the Teen Center around the first of March. With regular attendance of this class, students will have the opportunity to participate in this culminating activity, debate the issues, present persuasive speeches, and cross examine peers who present opposing view points.
