TIMES: 7:40 a.m. to 1:20 p.m. with two 15-minute breaks from 9:20-9:35 and 11:20-11:35. Classes meet five hours per day.

SUMMER SCHOOL INFORMATION

1. All students registering must be currently attending a CVUSD secondary school. *Any student not currently attending a CVUSD school, including those registered for the 2008-2009 school year, or residing outside the CVUSD may register on an availability basis from 10:30 - 11:00 a.m.*
2. The student does NOT need to be present on registration day. However, the person registering the student for a class must have the student's C.V.U.S.D. identification number.
3. A student is only allowed 6 hours of absence (for any reason) per three-week semester to receive credit for the semester class.
4. A student tardy 15 or more minutes is charged with two hours absence.
5. A student tardy less than 15 minutes is charged with a one hour absence.
6. Students taking any class to move ahead must complete both semesters.
7. Students taking World History or US History as a move-ahead class will be granted 10 credits at the completion of the full six weeks. Taking only first semester as a move ahead will not be allowed.

Classes designated with an asterisk (*) are only for students needing to repeat a class. Students who want to repeat or move ahead may take all other classes. All classes must have a minimum of 28 students or the class will not be offered.
