- _____ subject dividers (15 -16 dividers)
- _____ 1-2 zipper pouches (canvas, if possible) or pencil boxes
- _____ at least two black or blue ball point pens
- _____ 1 Uni-ball roller
- _____ 2 green or red ball point pens
- _____ pencils - a dozen regular #2, the rest can be mechanical if you like; don't forget lead
- _____ small pencil sharpener with a compartment to catch shavings
- _____ 12" ruler
- _____ book covers for the books you keep at home
- _____ at least two highlighter markers (not yellow)
- _____ glue stick
- _____ set of assorted colored pencils' (**BEST CHOICE: ARTIST QUALITY SPECTRA COLOR OR PRANG**)
- _____ 2- three-holed punched single-subject spiral notebooks with different color covers if possible (college or wide rule, needs to fit in your notebook)
- _____ one composition book
- _____ 1 box each ultra-fine black Sharpie and fine black Sharpie
- _____ small pair of scissors
- _____ inexpensive calculator
- _____ one box of Kleenex (to your homeroom teacher)
